Together, this committed team works to create sustainable, meaningful change, fostering resilience and empowerment within marginalized communities.




OUR ACTIVITIES:

Women Empowerment

1. Facilitating Self-Help Groups (SHGs):

Every Saturday at the Al Ansaar Centre in Alahalli, over 150 women gather to participate in Self-Help Groups, where empowerment takes shape! These groups promote self-financing, enabling women to collaboratively meet their needs and tackle challenges together. By fostering cooperation and financial independence, we equip women with the tools to lead self-sufficient lives. Many of these women manage their households while taking care of their children, balancing responsibilities with grace. Our SHGs provide a supportive environment where they can share experiences, learn, and grow together.

2. Empowering Women Entrepreneurs:

We recognize the immense potential of women entrepreneurs, especially those who juggle home and work life. By identifying and supporting dedicated individuals, we provide funding of up to 10,000 rupees, sparking growth and innovation in their businesses. This financial boost acts as a catalyst, unlocking new opportunities for women to thrive in entrepreneurship, contributing not only to their families' well-being but also to the economic development of slums. By investing in women who work from home, we enable them to create flexible business solutions that fit their family lives while expanding their entrepreneurial ventures.



Assistance To Poor

At Al Ansaar Trust, we believe that compassion has the power to change lives. Our unwavering commitment to supporting goes beyond traditional charity. While we do not have a dedicated institution, we immerse ourselves in the local community, working tirelessly to create a nurturing environment for those who need it most.

In our mission to uplift the vulnerable, we take meaningful steps to make a difference:

1. Ensuring Basic Needs: We provide a monthly ration of ₹1500 to address the fundamental needs of food security. This support ensures that the destitute, elderly, and orphans enjoy a warm meal. It also saves them from the embarrassing situation of going out to beg or asking from neighbours / strangers.





Healthcare:

Fairmeds, we offer free medication to poor those battling illness. Our healthcare initiatives are vital, especially for the elderly poor and destitute who often suffer in silence..

Al Ansaar Trust actively supports underprivileged individuals who struggle with healthcare expenses by encouraging them to use their Below Poverty Line (BPL) cards to access free or subsidized medical services available through various government schemes. We personally direct these patients to appropriate government hospitals, collaborating with hospital representatives who specialize in guiding them. These professionals help individuals understand the rules and navigate the available benefits, ensuring they can access quality healthcare without financial burden. Through this initiative, the organization empowers those in need to make the most of government health schemes, ensuring that lack of awareness or funds does not prevent them from receiving essential medical care.

Counseling

Al Ansaar Trust is dedicated to holistic community development through our counseling initiatives. Our individual and group sessions provide a supportive space for students and parents to discuss mental health, academic stress and drug awareness.
